## XXVII Conference of the European **Association of Fisheries Economists - EAFE**

The economic future of fisheries: resilience to climate change effects and innovation for the fulfilment of the SDGs

Large scale fisheries face challenges from disruptions in the value chain and policy restrictions, ranging from the Landing Obligation to closures for biodiversity conservation. Small-scale coastal fisheries are threatened by the loss of fishing grounds due to offshore renewable energy developments, shifts in species distribution due to climate change or other environmental factors, and lack of generational turnove. Meanwhile, aquaculture continues to experience a worldwide surge yet faces specific constraints in Europe. These pressures keep awakening new interest in the portfolio of solutions that economics brings to policymakers, managers, and all directly and indirectly involved in fisheries and aquaculture.

This event contributes to the debate by giving the floor to the latest knowledge available and facilitating direct interaction among fisheries and aquaculture economics researchers, knowledge brokers, experienced managers and

promising students, offering diverse networking activities.

This year's EAFE conference also reintroduced the policy day format brought by the economic unit of the EU Directorate General for Maritime Affairs and Fisheries, DG MARE. In addition, the session coordinated by the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) will discuss "The economic future of fisheries: resilience to climate change effects and innovation for the fulfilment of the SDGs". Of great interest for attendees also the speech "On the 'Beyond' in knowledge creation" by Pavel Salz, (Framian). The conference is honoured to welcome representatives of several other international fisheries and economic organisations, including those from the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD), the Association of National Organisations of Fishing Enterprises in the European Union (Europêche), Federazione del Mare, Assoittica Italia.
